FAIR HOUSING IS YOUR RIGHT!

....."If you have been denied your housing rights....you may have experienced unlawful discrimination"

IT IS UNLAWFUL TO DISCRIMINATE IN HOUSING BASED ON THESE FACTORS:

- ✓ Age (over 18)
- ✓ Race
- **✓** Color
- ✓ National origin
- ✓ Religion
- ✓ Sex
- Familial Status (families with children under the age of 18, or who are expecting a child)
- ✓ You, or someone close to you, has a mental or physical disability
- Sexual orientation
- ✓ Gender Identity
- ✓ Marital Status
- Victims of Domestic Violence (this includes being threatened and/or seeking a restraining order)

BASED ON THOSE FACTORS, IT IS AGAINST THE LAW TO:

- Refuse to rent or sell you housing;
- ✓ Tell you housing is unavailable when in fact it is available;
- ✓ Show you apartments or homes only in certain neighborhoods;
- Set different terms, conditions, or privileges for sale or rental of housing;
- Refuse to provide you with information regarding mortgage loans, deny you a mortgage loan, or impose different terms or conditions on a mortgage loan;
- Harass, coerce, intimidate, or interfere with anyone exercising or assisting someone with their fair housing rights;
- Conduct property appraisals in a discriminatory manner;
- Deny you property insurance;
- Refuse to make certain modifications or accommodations for persons with a mental or physical disability, including persons with HIV/AIDS-related illnesses and persons recovering from alcohol and substance abuse;
- Fail to design and construct housing in an accessible manner;
- Advertise a preference or limitation.

IF YOU BELIEVE YOUR RIGHTS HAVE BEEN VIOLATED...

- Rhode Island Legal Services, the Rhode Island Commission for Human Rights or HUD are ready to help you file a complaint.
- After your information is received, Rhode Island Legal Services or the Rhode Island Commission for Human Rights will contact you to discuss the concerns you raise.
